Mandated Changes for Rocky Mountain HMO and PPO Basic and Standard Health Benefit Plans for Colorado

Benefits will be modified for the HMO and PPO Basic and Standard Health Benefit Plans for Colorado effective January 1, 2008. The Colorado state regulation that determines the benefits of the plans is amended every other year. The changes are based on a survey of health plans in Colorado done by the Colorado Division of Insurance. The survey is conducted in an effort to keep the mandated plans current with trends in the commercial health plan market.

The changes will be effective January 1, 2008, for all groups regardless of the group's anniversary date. Premium rates will not change unless the group's anniversary is January. The groups will continue to renew as scheduled with premium rate changes corresponding with the group's anniversary.

Amendments to the groups' RMHP Health Benefits Contract will be mailed next week.

The benefit modifications are summarized in the Benefit Changes document, attached. A sample cover letter and amendment are also attached for your reference.
