Newborn Waiver

Rocky Mountain Health Plans is required by law, to provide coverage from the moment of a newborn's birth through the baby's first 31 days. Premium that may be due for a newborn will begin on the first day of the month following the date of birth.

We recognize that some families and individuals may not want this additional coverage for their newborn. RMHP will now allow mom or dad to waive the mandatory coverage and avoid payment of any associated premium, if the newborn has health coverage on a different health plan effective on the date of birth.

The RMHP Newborn Coverage Waiver Form must be completed and signed and sent to RMHP within 31 days from the date of birth. Employees with coverage through an employer group must submit this Waiver Form through their Plan Administrator.
