Good Health National Access

How to get Members enrolled

Effective January 1, 2006, Rocky Mountain Health Plans introduced Good Health National Access, which provides in-network benefits to participating providers outside of Colorado. This access is now available to:

- Eligible dependent children and spouses of employees enrolled in our group HMO plans who live outside of Colorado
- Employees who live and work out of state

We have had a very good response to this offering and are taking this opportunity to clarify the enrollment and disenrollment criteria.

ENROLLMENT

- Employees can elect to enroll in Good Health National Access as follows:
 - At date of hire
 - During open enrollment
 - When enrolling a newly eligible dependent, or
 - When a previously enrolled eligible dependent moves out of state, to be effective the first of the month following 30 days after the request
- Employees must go through their employer to enroll, using the RMHP Enrollment Form (for new employees) or the Change Form (for existing employees). This process insures the Employer is aware of the expanded access. The RMHP Enrollment Form and Change Form have been updated and provide a specific area to elect Good Health National Access. Remember that for small groups, no more than 15% of enrolled employees can reside outside the service area.

DISENROLLMENT

Once a Member elects Good Health National Access, he or she can disenroll:

- When he or she moves back into the service area
- During open enrollment, or
- When his or her policy with RMHP terminates

Again, employees must contact their employer and complete the RMHP Change Form to disenroll from Good Health National Access.

Annual Underwriting Review Change in Broker Notification effective June 1st

The RMHP Annual Underwriting Review process includes sending a short survey for employer groups to complete to provide updated employer group information. This initial request is sent 105 days in advance of the employer's anniversary. We receive the majority of these updates back right away. RMHP will send three reminder letters to employers if the survey is not received by specific dates.

Beginning June 1st, RMHP will provide copies of these notices to you for the reminder letters only.
