## Version D.0 Compound Claims Processing

Prior to the full integration of NCPDP version D.0 (vD.0) on January 1, 2012, a **transition period will occur beginning October 1, 2011**. As vD.0 contains significant updates to compound claims processing, Express Scripts will begin accepting selected changes in processing these claims during the transition period. These changes include:

A minimum of two (2) NDCs are required for the claim to be considered a Compound. At least one of the NDCs must be a federal legend drug.	Yes	Yes	Yes
