### About this plan.

Rocky Mountain Health Plans DualCare Plus (HMO D-SNP) is a Medicare Advantage HMO plan with a Medicare contract.

To join this plan, you must be entitled to Medicare Part A, be enrolled in Medicare Part B, live within our service area listed below, and be a United States citizen or lawfully present in the United States.

This plan is a Dual Eligible Special Needs Plan (D-SNP) for people who have both Medicare and Medicaid. How much Medicaid covers depends on your income, resources and other factors.

You can enroll in this plan if you are in one of these Medicaid categories:

- Qualified Medicare Beneficiary Plus (QMB+):** You get Medicaid coverage of Medicare cost-share and are also eligible for full Medicaid benefits. Medicaid pays your Part A and Part B premiums, deductibles, coinsurance and copayment amounts. You pay nothing, except for Part D prescription drug copays.
- Specified Low-Income Medicare Beneficiary (SLMB+):** Medicaid pays your Part B premium and provides full Medicaid benefits. You are eligible for full Medicaid benefits. At times you may also be eligible for limited assistance from your state Medicaid agency in paying your Medicare cost share amounts. Generally your cost share is 0% when the service is covered by both Medicare and Medicaid. There may be cases where you have to pay cost sharing when a service or benefit is not covered by Medicaid.
- Full Benefits Dual Eligible (FBDE):** Medicaid may provide limited assistance with Medicare cost-sharing. Medicaid also provides full Medicaid benefits. You are eligible for full Medicaid benefits. At times you may also be eligible for limited assistance from the State Medicaid Office in paying your Medicare cost share amounts. Generally your cost share is 0% when the service is covered by both Medicare and Medicaid. There may be cases where you have to pay cost sharing when a service or benefit is not covered by Medicaid.

If your category of Medicaid eligibility changes, your cost share may also increase or decrease. You must recertify your Medicaid enrollment to continue to receive your Medicare coverage.

### **Use network providers and pharmacies.**

Rocky Mountain Health Plans DualCare Plus (HMO D-SNP) has a network of doctors, hospitals, pharmacies, and other providers. If you use providers or pharmacies that are not in our network, the plan may not pay for those services or drugs, or you may pay more than you pay at a network pharmacy.

## Medicaid Benefits

Coverage of the benefits described below depends upon your level of Medicaid eligibility. No matter what your level of Medicaid eligibility is, Rocky Mountain Health Plans DualCare Plus (HMO D-SNP) will cover the benefits described in the Covered Medical and Hospital Benefits section of the Summary of Benefits. If you have questions about your Medicaid eligibility and what benefits you are entitled to, call Health First Colorado (Colorado's Medicaid Program), 1-844-235-2387.

Medicaid may pay your Medicare cost sharing amount, but it will depend on your Medicaid eligibility level. If Medicare doesn't cover a service or a benefit has run out, Medicaid may help, but you may have to pay a cost share. Please see your Medicaid Member Handbook for details on the cost sharing and additional benefits covered.

## Understanding the Benefits

- ✓ Review the full list of benefits found in the Evidence of Coverage (EOC), especially for those services that you routinely see a doctor. Call us or go online to view a copy of the EOC. Our phone number and website are listed on the back cover of this book.
- ✓ Review the Provider Directory (or ask your doctor) to make sure the doctors you see now are in the network. If they are not listed, it means you will likely have to select a new doctor.
- ✓ Review the Pharmacy Directory to make sure the pharmacy you use for any prescription medicines is in the network. If the pharmacy is not listed, you will likely have to select a new pharmacy for your prescriptions.

## Understanding Important Rules

- ✓ In addition to your monthly plan premium, you must continue to pay your Medicare Part B premium unless your Part B premium is paid for you by Medicaid or another third party. This premium is normally taken out of your Social Security check each month.
- ✓ Benefits, premiums and/or copays/coinsurance may change on January 1 of each year.
- ✓ Except in emergency or urgent situations, we do not cover services by out-of-network providers (doctors who are not listed in the provider directory).
- ✓ This plan is a Dual Eligible Special Needs Plan (D-SNP). Your ability to enroll will be based on verification that you are entitled to both Medicare and medical assistance from a state plan under Medicaid.
